**Center for Support for Women from Kikinda** invites organizations or companies with proven experience and expertise in monitoring and evaluation of projects, to participate in project monitoring on accessibility and quality of support services for victims of sexual violence in AP Vojvodina „**Path to recovery: Improving the services for victims of sexual violence in Vojvodina**“, which is implemented with the support of the United Nations Trust Fund to End Violence Against Women - UN Trust Fund to end Violence Against Women (UN Trust Fund).

Center for Support of Women is one of the leading women's non-governmental organizations in Serbia and provides specialized support services for women in situations of gender-based violence. During the past 18 years, Center for Support of Women has been working on improving the position of women, establishing gender equality and equal opportunity policies. The Center provides support services to women victims of gender-based violence, such as licensed SOS helpline, psycho-social support and legal counseling, and is the only organization in Serbia that provides a specialized service of psycho-social support for women and girls victims of sexual violence, within four health institutions in Vojvodina. Support services enable women and girls to overcome the trauma of the experienced violence and continue life without violence.

We are inviting organizations or companies which have experience in preparing such or similar reports on monitoring and evaluation of projects, as well as experience in research work in the field of gender-based violence in AP Vojvodina, dedicated and motivated team, sensitized in the field of gender equality.

We will work together to improve the accessibility and quality of support services for victims of sexual violence in AP Vojvodina, as well as to improve the institutional response to cases of sexual violence and the cooperation of competent institutions within the protection system.
